

# Device Administration Rights Permission Slip



Dear Parent/Guardian,

As part of our Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program, we provide you with the option of allowing us to put administration rights onto your child's device. This will stop any installation of software that is not already on the device. This is absolutely optional. If you would like your child to be able to download and install software on their device, then you will not want to have administrator rights put onto the device.

The primary reason for installing administration rights is to stop video games, Spotify, Discord (chat rooms), Steam (game engine) and other third-party software applications from being installed onto the device. These applications slow the device down dramatically and can potentially be unsafe environments for primary school-aged children without supervision.

The reason we need to ask for your permission is because you own the device. We can't legally put administration rights onto the device without your permission. It is not school property. We can also remove the administration rights at any time, so if you decide to change your mind we can revert it back to original settings.
